- Nominators may submit any other pertinent documentation to support their nomination (maximum 3 pages).

NOTE: A convincing nomination presentation is concise and to the point. To assist the jurors in their work, the support materials presented to the jury will be strictly limited to 10 pages: a curriculum vitae, 5 pages; the statement supporting the nomination, 1 page; the biography 1 page; and other pertinent documentation, 3 pages.
